Mumbai boy wins award at NYIFF

MUMBAI, DHNS: An 11-year-old slum kid from Mumbai, Sunny Pawar has won the best child actor award for film Chippa at the prestigious 19th New York Indian Film Festival (NYIFF) 2019.

The awards were presented by Indian-American Arts Council from 7-13 May. The 19th NYIFF had the largest number of Hindi and Indian regional language films showcased at the festival.

Chippa is a story about the aspirations of a child who lives on the streets, told through a journey he takes into an enchanting world that he creates himself on one wintry night in Kolkata.

Earlier in the film Lion Sunny Pawar was also nominated for the Critics Choice Awards in the "Best Young Performer" Category, "Best Actor" by AACTA Awards, "Special Mention Grand Jury Prize" at Asia Pacific Screen Awards and a nomination for the "Young Artist Award".

The film has a supporting cast of Chandan Roy Sanyal, Masood Akhtar, Sumeet Thakur and Mala Mukherjee in pivotal roles and is produced by Ultra Media, Travelling Light & Victory Media.
